

## Detailed saleyard report - sheep and lamb

Numbers lifted and quality ranged from the plainer lightweights to well finished trade weights and heavier lambs, with the majority carrying a good skin. The bulk yarded fell into the 20 to 24/kg cwt category with fair percentages also heavier in weight. There were ample lightweights mainly selling to processor orders.

Trade weights lost \$5 to \$6 to range from \$100 to \$132/head or an average price from 488c to 495c/kg cwt.

Heavy lambs slipped \$3 as the lighter weights also selling to the trade and supermarkets ranged from \$122 to \$134, while the heaviest reached \$152/head. These categories attained an average price from 455c to 475c/kg cwt.

Mutton numbers nearly doubled and values remained firm to \$2/head dearer. The medium weights sold from \$95 to \$130/head, the latter for Merino wethers carrying a good skin value. Heavy weight crossbred ewes reached \$133/head. The better finished sheep averaged from 427c to 464c/kg cwt.
