Numbers lifted with quality ranging from lightweights suitable for restockers to well finished fresh trade weight new season lambs. There were around 6,000 new season lambs with large percentages falling into the lightweight categories. Old trade and heavy weight lambs were limited in number.

Lightweight young lambs to restockers and processors eased \$5 to \$6 to sell from \$80.50 to \$107/head. New season trade weights lost \$2 to \$3/head on, however the fresher pens lost very little. Trade weights ranged from \$107 to \$136/head or 503c to 520c/kg cwt. Heavy new season lambs slipped \$2 to \$4 to sell from \$132 to \$152/head or 503c to 518c/kg cwt.

The few old lambs reached \$166/head for a pen estimated to weigh over 30kg cwt.

Sheep numbers lifted and quality remained mixed as values eased with a major processor failing to attend. Lightweight ewes sold as low as \$15/head, however very little processing value was evident. Medium and heavy weight mutton sold cheaper by \$5 to \$6 to range from \$70 to \$114.50/head with the ewe portion averaging 309c/kg cwt. There were large runs of young wethers selling from \$73.80 to \$88/head.
