Consignments lifted, however another small offering of mixed quality lambs was offered. There were around 1,400 new season lambs yarded, however large percentages were lightweights and suitable for restocker purchases. Some well finished trade and heavy weight old lambs were penned in a firm to dearer market.

New season trade weights lifted \$5 to range from \$120 to \$140/head or from 551c to 560c/kg cwt. Old lightweights gained \$2 to \$3 as the trade weights remained similar in value compared to the previous market to sell from \$106 to \$125/head or 480c to 489c/kg cwt.

Heavy lambs lifted \$2 to \$3 as the lighter weights sold from \$124 to \$148, while the heaviest reached \$150/head. These categories ranged from 495c to 515c/kg cwt.

Sheep were again limited in number and values remained solid throughout most categories. Medium and heavy weights ranged from \$77 to \$136/head with the ewes averaging 386c, while the wether portion averaged 381c with the highest sheep value reached 445c/kg cwt.
